PRAYER :-

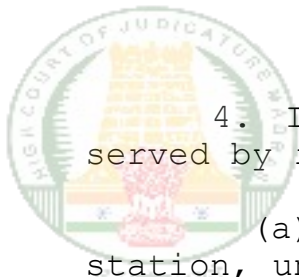
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime.No. Not known of 2020 on the
file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners,
learned counsel for the intervenor and the learned Government
Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b)
and 506(i) of I.P.C., in Crime No. not known of 2020 on the file of
the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned
Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that only complaint
has been given against the petitioners and till date no F.I.R. has
been registered against them.



4. I am of the view that the interest of justice will be served by issuing following directions :

(a) The petitioners will not be summoned to the police station, unless it is given in writing.

(b) If any FIR is registered against the petitioners, the respondent will give due intimation to the petitioners. So that the petitioners can approach the appropriate Court for the relief of anticipatory bail. In other words, the petitioners will be given sufficient breathing time to move the Court.

5. With these directions, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of.
