PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.245 of 2020 on the file of
the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the
learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioners apprehending arrest at the hands of the
respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 147,
148, 294(b), 427, 323, 336 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., r/w Section 4 of
Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 1998, in Crime
No. 245 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) points out that as many as 8 persons suffered simple injuries and that the case has a political background.

4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, on instructions, gives an undertaking that the petitioner will keep away from the de-facto complainant and other victims. If the petitioner is breached this undertaking, I will not hesitate to cancel this anticipatory bail.

5.Recording the undertaking given by the petitioners, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District, and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two common sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of eight(8) weeks from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.

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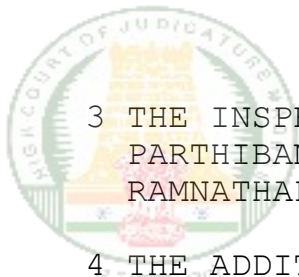
