PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.274 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police

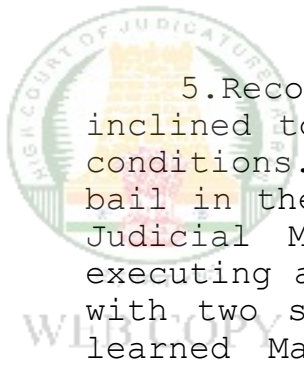
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 354(A), 354(D), 294(b) and 506(ii) of I.P.C., and Section 4 of Women Harassment Act, in Crime No. 274 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3.The allegation against the petitioner is that he showed obscene video to the complainant.

4.The petitioner through his counsel gives an undertaking that he will file an affidavit before the Court that he will respect womanhood and that he will not interfere with the life of the de-facto complainant. If the petitioner breaches this undertaking, I will not hesitate to cancel the anticipatory bail.



5. Recording the undertaking given by the petitioner, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Karaikudi, Sivagangai District, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of eight(8) weeks from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
