PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

for Bail in Crime No.6 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is arrayed as A2. She was arrested and remanded to Judicial Custody on 10.03.2020 for the offences punishable under sections 406, 420, 506(i), 120(b) of I.P.C in Crime No.6 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police. She Seeks bail.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner contended that even though statutory period is over, charge sheet is not filed.

4. Hence, the petitioner is granted default bail. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the following conditions;



(i) the petitioner shall be released on own bond by the Magistrate without insisting on sureties. However, the petitioner is directed to execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Ramanathapuram, after the concerned Court is reopened on regular basis.

(ii) the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(iii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560].
