PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

To enlarge the Petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest in connection with the case in Cr.No. 51 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police and pass orders as this Honble Court.

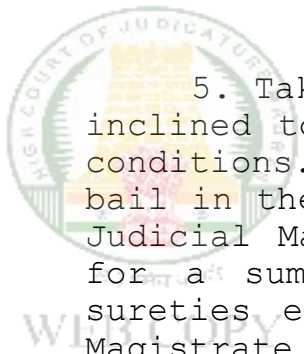
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under section 366(A) of I.P.C., in Crime No.51 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) states that the victim girl is studying in 8th standard and that the petitioner and others had kidnapped her with an intention to marry her. But, it appears that on coming to know that the police is searching them, they had abandoned the girl and ran away.

4. The petitioner gives an undertaking that he will stay away from Karur District for a period of three months and keep away from the girl from today. It is made clear that if the petitioner again gets in contact with the girl and a complaint is received from the girl's father, I will not hesitate to cancel the anticipatory bail.



5. Taking note of the undertaking given by the petitioner, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kulithalai, and on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed.
