PRAYER :-

for Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.375 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 294(b), 323, 429, 506(2) and 324 of I.P.C., in Crime No.375 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with one Vengatesh abused the *de facto* complainant using filthy language and they also caused injury on the *de facto* complainant. Hence, the complainant.

4. The learned Government Advocate (crl.side) appearing for the State would submit that the offences mentioned above are bailable in
