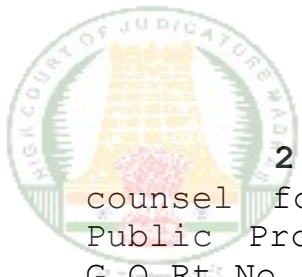

Challenging the order of detention in Cr.M.P.No.39/2020 dated 22.05.2020 passed by the second respondent, branding the detenu, namely, Sarathkumar, Son of Rajamanickam, male, aged about 27 years, as "Sand Offender" as contemplated under Section 2(gg) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982, his father has filed this habeas corpus petition.



2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.3094, Home, Prohibition & Excise (XII) Department, dated 23.07.2020, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked.

3. Recording the above submissions, the habeas corpus petition is closed.
