PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 1321 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent.

2. The petitioner apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Section 379 of I.P.C., 1860 and Section 21(2) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 in Crime No.1321 of 2020, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner illegally transported one unit of river sand by using TATA 407 Mini Van bearing Regn.No.TN-31-E-3109. Hence, a case has been registered.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the State would submit that the quantity of sand involved is one unit and the same was recovered by the respondent police.



5. Taking note of the above facts, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner by imposing conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manapparai, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.80,000/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand only) before the concerned District Mineral and Foundation Trust on or before 15.07.2020, without prejudice and subject to outcome of the trial;

(c) petitioner shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation;

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]**; and;

(g) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
