PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 to 4 to initiate appropriate action against the 5th respondent for taking illegal electricity loop connection in Service connection 76 by laying underground electric line to S.F.No.396 situated at Periyamanjuveli Village & Post, Aravakurichi Taluk, Karur District, consequently direct to disconnect the illegal electricity loop connection in Service connection 76 in the bore well situated in S.F.No.396 on the basis of the petitioner's representation dated 10.12.2019.

ORDER

2.Since the dispute in the writ petition lies in a short compass as to whether the 5th respondent has drawn connection from the petitioner's land, I am inclined to direct the respondents 1 to 4 to dispose of the petitioner's representation dated 10.12.2019.

3.Accordingly, the official respondents are directed to consider and pass appropriate orders on the representation dated 10.12.2019 of the petitioner after giving notice to the private respondent viz., the 5th respondent, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, on merits and in accordance with law.

4.This writ petition is disposed of with the above direction. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
