PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.10 of 2014 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offences under Section 498(A) of IPC and Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, in connection with Non-Bailable Warrant issued in C.C.No.58 of 2015, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The petitioner was absent during the trial in C.C.No.58 of 2015 before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi. Therefore, Non-Bailable Warrant came to be issued on 06.05.2019.

3.The learned counsel for the appearing for the petitioner submitted that due to illness, the petitioner could not appear before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi and therefore, Non-Bailable Warrant was issued against him on 06.05.2019. He further submitted that the act of the petitioner is neither wilful nor wanton and prays for anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
