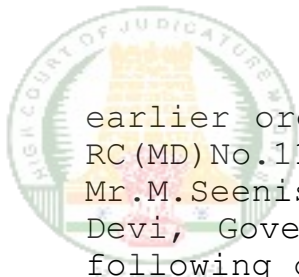
Prayer in CRL MP(MD).No.3584 of 2020 :-

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, to Extend the time granted in condition(b) of the order passed by this Honourable Court to deposit a sum of Rs.25000/- in Crl.R.C.(MD) No.117 of 2019 dated 05/04/2019 on the file of this Honourable Court.
