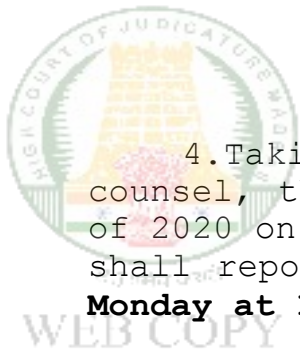

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the condition imposed by this court in CrI.O.P.(MD)No.6338 of 2020, on 23.06.2020 regularly and he prayed for relaxation of the said condition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (CrI.Side) submitted that the petitioner has been complying with the condition regularly from 26.06.2020 and the investigation has been completed.
