Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court Directing the 1st respondent i.e., the Principal Secretary to Government, Water Supply and Municipal Administration Department, Chennai to pass appropriate orders on the petitioners representation dated 06.07.2019 regarding his notional promotion as Bill Collector/Junior Assistant with effect from 1997 on par with his juniors and similarly placed persons based on the proceedings No. 32872/Na.Pa.3/97-1 dated 24.10.1997 of the Director of Municipal Administration, Chennai and revised pension proposals calculating the petitioners notional promotion and increments on par with his juniors may be ordered to be sent to the Assistant director of Local Fund Audit, Chennai
