2.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, Mr.R.Anandharaj, learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the representation of the petitioner was favourable considered by the third respondent and the petitioner's husband was granted three days leave by an order dated 27.08.2020. It is further submitted that the convict has not availed leave as there is no bus facility for travelling from Madurai to Salem and whenever, the convict is ready, he can avail the leave already granted by the third respondent.
