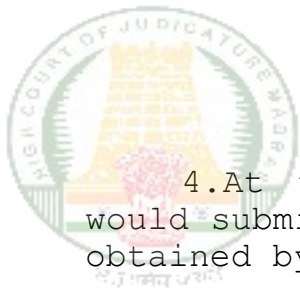
O R D E R

2.Today, when the petition is came up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2, on instructions, would submit that the complaint of the petitioner dated 01.07.2020 has been received by the second respondent and based on which, an enquiry has been initiated in C.S.R.No.120/2020. He would further submit that during the time of enquiry, both the petitioners undertook to vacate the salt pan. Hence, the enquiry initiated in C.S.R.No.120/2020 has been closed.
