O R D E R

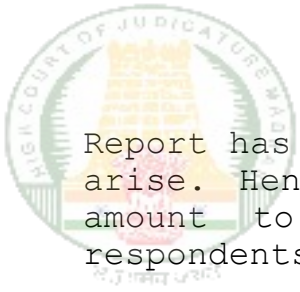
This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to direct the respondents 2 and 3 not to harass the petitioner under the guise of enquiry.
