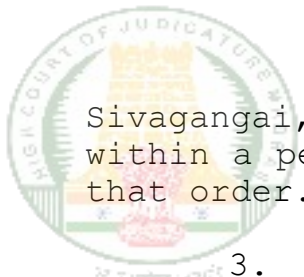
Prayer :-
