2. This Court, by an order dated 01.07.2020 in Crl.OP.(MD) No.5749 of 2020, granted anticipatory bail to the petitioner on condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (criminal side).

4. According to the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) the petitioner is complying with the conditions imposed by this Court regularly and the investigation is substantially completed.

5. Considering the fact that the petitioner is regularly complying with the conditional order, the condition already imposed



on the petitioner is relaxed and the petitioner shall report before the respondent police once in a week i.e., on every Monday at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.
