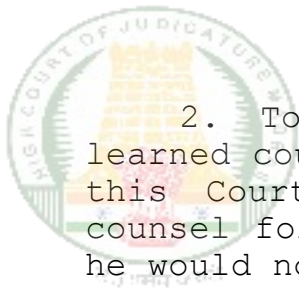

The accused counsel had undertaken to pay a certain sum of money to the defacto complainant. Recording his undertaking, this Court, granted anticipatory bail. Alleging that the accused has violated the undertaking, this petitioner / defacto complainant filed this petition.



2. Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the accused states that the condition imposed by this Court has substantially been complied with. The learned counsel for the accused gives a further undertaking that in future, he would not commit any default.
