2.Today, when the petition is came up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents 1 to 3, on instructions, would submit that based on the complaint given by the fourth respondent, the third respondent police initiated an enquiry in C.No.145/SPO/POR/2020 and after due enquiry, the same has been closed on 17.08.2020. According to him, as of now, no petition/complaint is pending against the petitioner.
