ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who are arrayed as Accused Nos.1 to 4,
apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the
offences punishable under sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(i) of
IPC, in Crime No.1669 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police,
seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to civil dispute,
there was a wordy quarrel between the petitioners and the defacto
complainant, in which, the petitioners said to have abused the
defacto complainant by using filthy language and also attacked him
with hands and leg and caused injuries. Based on the complaint given
by the defacto complainant, the crime has been registered against
the petitioners.

(f) if the accused/petitioners thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
