PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.46 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/2nd accused apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 420 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.46 of 2020, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner is running a registered employment service centre under the name and style of M/s.Rizia Employment Service. The petitioner along with A-1 said to have collected amount for more than Rs.1,80,00,000/- from the de-facto complainant and others by making a false promise that she would get appointment in Government or any other private company and thereby, she cheated all the persons. Hence, the complaint.



3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that A-1 alone has collected the money and the petitioner has no role played and she has falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the State would submit that the investigation reveals that this petitioner along with A-1 have collected money for more than Rs.1,80,00,000/- by making a false promise that she would get appointment from Government and thereby, cheated all the persons. Hence, the case has been registered.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the petitioner along with A-1 said to have collected money from the de-facto complainant and other persons by making a false promise and cheated all the persons, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence, this petition stands dismissed.
