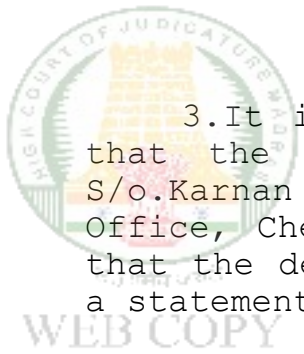

3.It is submitted by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor that the detainee was having love affair with one Dhanasekar, S/o.Karnan and they registered their marriage at Sub Registrar Office, Chennai North Joint on 21.08.2020. It is further submitted that the detainee appeared before Ayanavaram Police Station and gave a statement.

4.In the light of the above fact, no further order is necessary in this Habeas Corpus Petition and accordingly, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
