2. This writ petition was filed for securing the release of the petition mentioned vehicle. I had allowed the same since it was submitted by the respondents that the vehicle was not produced before the Court below. It appears that this was an incorrect statement made by the third respondent. The vehicle had been produced before the Court below. Therefore, the order passed by this Court on 17.08.2020, is recalled and the writ petition is dismissed.

3. Liberty is given to the petitioner to move the Court below for release of the vehicle. On receipt of such petition, the Court below shall dispose of the petition on merits and in



accordance with law within a period of 10 days. There shall be no order as to costs.
