2.The petitioner is aggrieved by the communication dated 04.03.2014 issued by the Revenue Divisional Officer, Dindugul to the Registration Authority. He has therefore moved a petition before the very same authority seeking recall of that communication.

3.It is seen that the petitioner's petition mentioned petition was taken on file and enquiry was also ordered. But on account of the intervention of the Pandemic, further process has not taken place.
