Despite lodging a complaint with the second respondent on 07.08.2020, no action was taken.

3.The detainee appeared before this Court today through video conferencing and she has stated that she was not willing to marry the person arranged by her mother and hence, she is now with her friend Amutha at Thanjavur.



4. In the light of the above fact, no further order is necessary in this Habeas Corpus Petition and accordingly, this Habeas Corpus Petition is closed.
