Prayer in CRL MP(MD).No.4201 of 2020:-

2.On the side of the petitioner, it is stated that this Court has granted bail to the petitioner on 12.05.2020, directing the petitioner to appear before the second respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m and 05.00 p.m. It is stated that the petitioner is complying the condition till now and prayed the condition to be relaxed.



3. On the side of the prosecution, it is stated that the petitioner is complying the condition till now.

4. In view of the submissions made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), this Court is inclined to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.A.(MD)No.136 of 2020 dated 12.05.2020. Hence, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is partly allowed by modifying the condition that the petitioner is directed to appear before the second respondent Police on every Wednesday at 10.30 a.m., until further order.
