3. The learned Additional Government Pleader states that in this case, First Information Report has been registered in Crime No.96 of 2019 on the file of the respondent and the vehicle has also been produced before the jurisdictional criminal Court in RPR No.245/2020.

4. Therefore, the petitioner has to necessarily move the jurisdictional criminal Court for release of the vehicle. On such application filed by the petitioner, it shall be disposed of within



a period of ten days. Giving such liberty to the petitioner, this writ petition stands dismissed. No costs. I make it clear that I have not gone into the matter.
