Prayer: Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to issue fresh legal heir certificate for petitioner's deceased father E.Andavan after making necessary corrections in the legal heir certificate dated 14.11.1996 issued by the second respondent on the basis of the representations made by the petitioner dated 15.06.2018 and 19.06.2018 within the time limit as fixed by this Court.

Heard the learned counsel on either side. By consent of both parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.The petitioner, A.Aravind was born on 18.04.1995. His father, E.Andavan passed away shortly thereafter (i.e., on 16.09.1995). The petitioner's father's demise was duly registered. Subsequently, a legal heir certificate was also obtained, but the name of the petitioner had been erroneously mentioned in the said legal heir certificate. Likewise, there is also a spelling error in respect of his father. Therefore, the petitioner wanted necessary corrections to be made in the said legal heir certificate dated 14.11.1996 in this regard. The petitioner had made quite a few representations, since they were not acted upon this writ petition came to be filed.

3.The learned Additional Government Pleader took notice and today, it is stated that the enquiry in the matter is completed and the papers have been forwarded to the Revenue Divisional Officer,
