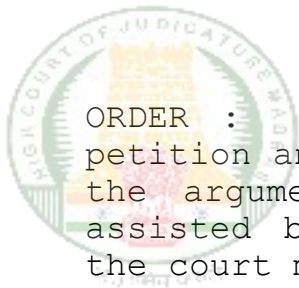

3.This Court, upon hearing the submissions of the learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the petitioner and on going through the affidavit filed in support of this petition, is of the view that extension of time is to be granted for complying the conditions.

4.Accordingly, this Court grants four weeks time, from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, to comply with the conditional order, failing which, interim order granted on 28.07.2020 stands vacated automatically without further reference to this Court.
