PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

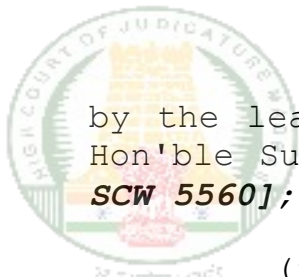
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.148 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners are arrayed as Accused No.1 and 2, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324, 427, 506(i) of I.P.C. and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Woman Act, in Crime No.148 of 2020, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that A-1 and A-2 are father-in-law and brother-in-law of the de-facto complainant. The de-facto complainant got married to one Tamil Ilakiya, the daughter of the 1st petitioner, due to family dispute, the daughter of the first petitioner went to her parental home. Therefore, the de-facto complainant and his mother went to the first petitioner's house and see his wife and children. At that time, there was a wordy quarrel



by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f)if the petitioners/accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
