PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Cr.No.277 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner who is arrayed as A-2 apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 379 of IPC, in Crime No.277 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that totally there are four accused in this case and the petitioner is arrayed as A-2. The petitioner said to have stolen two wheeler belongs to the defacto complainant. Hence, a complaint has been registered.

3. Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (criminal side).



4. The learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the petitioner is a habitual offender and there are two previous cases are pending against the petitioner.

5. Taking note of the submission of the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) and considering the fact that the petitioner is a habitual offender and there are two previous cases pending against the petitioner and hence, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
