diligence is shown by the petitioner's Counsel. Hence, this Court is inclined to allow this petition, however, on terms. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the delay is condoned on condition that the petitioner pay a sum of Rs.1,000/- to the Legal Services Authority within a period of two weeks from today, failing which, this petition shall stand automatically dismissed without further reference to Court.
