In this regard, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor would specifically state that during the time of enquiry, both the petitioner and his rival party undertake to resolve their disputes, by approaching the civil Court. The said submission is recorded.



3. In view of the above, no further orders is necessary in this Writ Petition. Hence, the Writ Petition is dismissed. No costs.
