3. The learned Additional Government Pleader states that in this case, First Information Report has been registered in Crime No.224 of 2020 on the file of the second respondent and the vehicle has also been produced before the jurisdictional criminal Court.

4. Therefore, the petitioner has to necessarily move the jurisdictional criminal Court for release of the vehicle. On such application filed by the petitioner, the jurisdiction criminal Court shall dispose of the petitioner's application within a period of ten days thereafter. Giving such liberty to the petitioner, this writ



petition stands disposed of. No costs. I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter.
