3.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the State would submit that upon the complaint given by the fifth respondent, the third respondent herein conducted an enquiry in C.S.R.No.438 of 2020 and thereafter, the same has been closed. He further submitted that as of now no enquiry/no enquiry is pending against the petitioner.



4. Therefore, in the absence of complaint against the petitioner, the respondent police shall not call the petitioner in the guise of enquiry and harass him.

5. Recording the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, this Criminal Original Petition is closed.
