Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ of mandamus, to direct the respondent to issue legal heir certificate for the demise of S.Chandrasekara Menon, the husband of the petitioner who died on 11.09.2018 leaving behind the petitioner and others as legal heirs by considering the online application of the petitioner dated 19.10.2019 within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondent.

2.The petitioner wants the respondent to issue legal heir certificate in respect of her husband S.Chandrasekara Menon. It is seen that the petitioner is a permanent resident of Kerala. S.Chandrasekara Menon is also permanent resident of Kerala. But he had worked as District Educational Officer in Kanyakumari. His demise was also in Kerala. The marriage, which is said to have taken place between S.Chandrasekara Menon and the petitioner was registered at Palugal, Tamilnadu.

3.Nothing had happened within the Taluk limits of Vilavancode.

Therefore, the Thasildar, Vilavancode expressed her inability to

consider the petitioner's case. The petitioner is not in a position to establish any territorial nexus also. Therefore, leaving open the petitioner's right to establish her case elsewhere, this writ petition is dismissed. No costs.
