PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

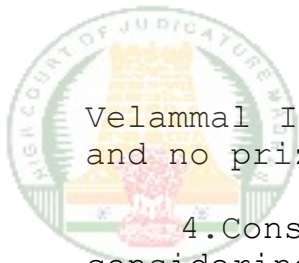
For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.218/2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who is arrayed as Accused No.1, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 4, 5(a) of Tamil Nadu Prize Schemes (Prohibition) Act 1979 and 420 of I.P.C., in Crime No.218 of 2020, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and other accused are running a Aram Makkal Nala Sangam and on 29.01.2020, the office bearers of the above said Sangam said to have conducted meeting, whereby given cars and other household articles to various subscribers without getting permission. Hence, the crime was registered.

3.Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the Inspector of Police, V2 Avaniyapuram Police Station, Madurai City, has filed a status report, stating that the petitioner and other accused only conducted meeting in



Velammal IDA Scudder Auditorium and they only honoured some people and no prize was given to anybody.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that as per the status report filed by the respondent police, stating that no prize was given to anybody, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai District, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(a)the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioner shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation;

(c)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

(f)if the accused/petitioner thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
