This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents 1 and 2 to produce the detainee namely Kameshwari, daughter of respondents 3 and 4 before this court and set her at liberty.

2.It is alleged by the Petitioner that in pursuance of the betrothal on 2.7.2020, the Petitioner was to marry the detainee on 28.8.2020, but on 27.08.2020, it was informed by the private respondents that their daughter was missing and hence this



3.Mr.V.Neelakandan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 and Mr.R.Mathiyalagan, learned counsel appearing for the detainee would state that even though the marriage of the detainee was fixed with the Petitioner herein on 28.8.2020, the detainee eloped with one Yuvaraj and married him on 27.08.2020. It is further informed that the marriage between the detainee and the said Yuvaraj was registered at Sub-Registrar's Office, Velayuthampalayam, Karur District.

4.In the light of the above facts, We are of the opinion that no further investigation is required in this Habeas Corpus Petition and accordingly, the same stands dismissed.
