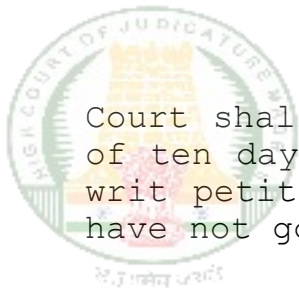
### **ORDER**

4.Therefore, the petitioner has to necessarily move the jurisdictional criminal Court for release of the vehicle. On such application being filed by the petitioner, the jurisdiction criminal



Court shall dispose of the petitioner's application within a period of ten days thereafter. Giving such liberty to the petitioner, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs. I make it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter.
