3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that due to pandemic situation they were not able to surrender the sureties before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Virudhunagar, within the prescribed time.

4.Heard the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) appearing for the respondent police.

Considering the facts and circumstances, time is extended by Two weeks from today and the petitioners are directed to surrender before the Court below on or before **01.10.2020** and also directed to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) to the credit of the Sri Ramakrishnan Sevalaya, Payampadi Post, 190, Kolathur, Kottivakkam, Madhurandagam, Kancheepuram - 603 309 (The Central Bank of India, Chithamur Branch Account No.2153949696, IFSC Code No.CBIN0281902) within a period of two weeks without prejudice to their rights and contentions before the trial Court.
