3.In the light of the above, this Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

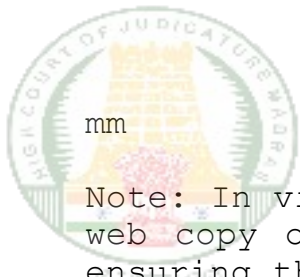
