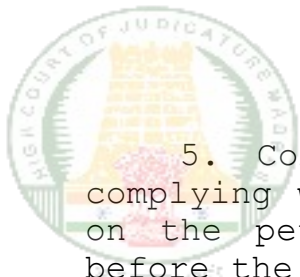

This petition has been filed to relax the condition.

2.This Court, by an order dated 28.08.2020 in Crl.OP.(MD) No.9078 of 2020, granted bail to the petitioners on condition that the petitioners should report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (criminal side).

4.According to the learned Government Advocate (criminal side) the petitioners are complying with the conditions imposed by this Court regularly from 01.09.2020 and the investigation is substantially completed.



5. Considering the fact that the petitioners are regularly complying with the conditional order, the condition already imposed on the petitioners are relaxed and the petitioners shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.
