PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to survey the land in S.No.395/5C5 in Perunjaiyur Village, Kurunthanam Kottai Group, Devakottai Taluk, Sivagangai District and issue patta in favour of the petitioner by considering the petitioner representation dated 25.09.2019.

ORDER

This writ petition is filed to direct the respondents to survey the land in Survey S.No.395/5C5 situated at Perunjaiyur Village, Kurunthanam Kottai Group, Devakottai Taluk, Sivagangai District and issue patta in favour of the petitioner, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 25.09.2019.

2. Mr.C.Ramesh, learned Special Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents. By consent, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that it is suffice, if a direction is issued to the second respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 25.09.2019.

4.The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents would submit that the petitioner's representation dated 25.09.2019 would be considered on merits and in accordance with law,



within a time frame to be fixed by this Court.

5. In agreement with the submission made by the learned Special Government Pleader, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Court is inclined to pass the following direction:-

(i) The second respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 25.09.2019 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the rival parties, if any. If there is any objection from the rival parties, the second respondent shall conduct the enquiry and communicate the decision to the parties concerned.

(ii) The aforesaid exercise shall be completed within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. This Writ Petition is disposed of, with the above directions. No costs.
