This Habeas Corpus Petition has been filed seeking direction to the second respondent to secure the detenu namely, Pothumponnu, aged 29 years and produced the person or corpus of the detenu before this Court and set her at liberty.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing today, Mr.S.Sukumar, learned counsel for the Petitioner would state that the dispute between the Petitioner and the detenu has been amicably settled between them before the second respondent/Police Station, yesterday. Hence, the learned counsel for the Petitioner seeks permission of this court to withdraw this Habeas Corpus Petition.



3.Mr.V.Neelakandan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 and 2 would state that the detainee appeared before the second respondent Police and there was an amicable settlement between the parties.

4.In the light of the above statement made on either side, no further enquiry is required in the Habeas Corpus Petition and accordingly, the same stands closed.
