PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No. 51 of 2009 on the file of the Respondent Police, in C.C.No.78 of 2010 on the file of Learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Ramanthapuram.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/ A2 herein was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 30.01.2020 for the alleged offence under Section 379 of IPC.

2. The case was registered in the year 2009 and the petitioner is said to have been absconding for nearly 11 years and recently the petitioner was arrested.

3. This the second bail petition. Earlier this Court by an order dated 22.07.2020 in CrI.O.P(MD) No.7330 of 2020 had dismissed the bail petition on the ground that petitioner is a habitual offender and also having previous cases of similar nature.



4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the case is posted for questioning under Section 313 of Cr.P.C.

5. Taking into consideration the fact that there is no change in circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Hence this petition stands dismissed. However the trial Court is directed to complete the trial proceedings within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
