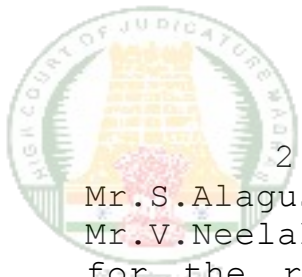

When the matter is taken up for hearing today, Mr.S.Alagusundar, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner and Mr.V.Neelakandan, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 would state that after filing the present Habeas Corpus Petition, the detainee was secured by the second respondent and she was produced before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Aundipatti and after recording her statement, the detainee was sent along with the Petitioner.

3. In view of the subsequent developments, this Court is of the opinion that no further investigation is required in this Habeas Corpus Petition and accordingly, the same stands dismissed.
