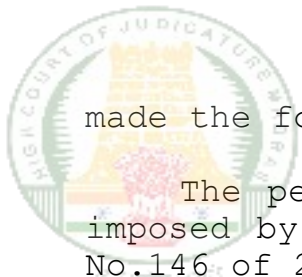
PRAYER IN CRL MP(MD)No.2824 of 2020 in CRL A(MD)No.146 of 2020:

Petition praying that in the circumstances stated therein and in the petition filed therewith the High Court may be pleased to suspend the sentence of Imprisonment imposed by the Learned Sessions Judge(FAC), Mahila Fast Track Court, Sivagangai in S.C.No.23 of 2016 dated 10/03/2020 and enlarge the petitioners / Appellants on bail, pending disposal of the above said Criminal Appeal and thus render justice.

PRAYER IN CRL A(MD) No.146 of 2020:

Pleased to set aside the Judgment and Conviction dated 10.03.2020 by learned Sessions Judge(FAC), Mahila Fast Track Court, Sivagangai in S.C.No.23 of 2016 and acquit the Appellants.

Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr.D.RAMESH KUMAR, Advocate for the Appellants and of Mr.R.SARAVANA KUMAR, Government Advocate, on behalf of the Respondent, the court
