PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the 2nd respondent to issue 'No Objection Certificate' in favour of the petitioner so as to participate in the selection process of the 1st respondent for the post of Sub Inspector of Police in Tamil Nadu Police Subordinate Service vide notification dated 08.03.2019.

O R D E R

The petitioner's candidature, being a departmental candidate, came to be rejected on the ground that certain charges were pending against him as on the date of the notification for the post of Sub Inspector of Police.

2. The notification issued by Tamil Nadu Uniformed Services Recruitment Board in No.2 of 2019, dated 08.03.2019, prescribes the eligibility criteria for the departmental quota candidates as 20% and one of the conditions required for applying under the departmental quota is that, the candidates should have a clean record without any punishment other than minor punishments of black mark, reprimand and censure in their entire service.

3. In the instant case, the petitioner herein was imposed with the punishment of postponement of increment for a period of two years without cumulative effect, vide proceedings of the second respondent, dated 17.10.2016. As such, the petitioner may not be qualified to seek for 20% quota for departmental candidates.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, I do not find any reason to direct the second respondent to issue 'No Objection Certificate' in favour of the petitioner. Accordingly,



the Writ Petition stands dismissed. However, there shall be no order as to costs.
