PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

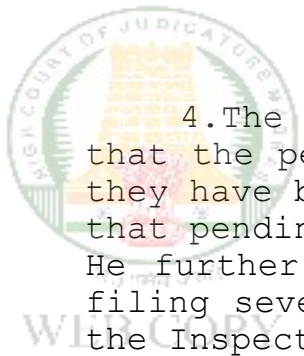
PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.177 of 2020 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners who are arrayed as A-1 & A-3 apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 341, 294(b), 427 & 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.177 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that totally there are three accused. The petitioners are brothers. Due to some previous enmity between the parties, on 19.08.2020 at 02.30 p.m., the petitioners said to have waylaid the defacto complainant and abused him using filthy language and assaulted with wooden log and also criminally intimidated him. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent.



4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are brothers and they are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that pending complaint, A-2 was murdered by the defacto complainant. He further submitted that the defacto complainant has deliberately filing several complainant against the petitioners with the help of the Inspector of Police. Hence, he seek anticipatory bail.

5.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), on instructions, submitted that the petitioners said to have assaulted the defacto complainant. He further submitted that pending investigation A-2 was murdered by the defacto complainant and investigation is still pending.

6.Considering the fact and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that pending investigation of this case A-2 was murdered by the defacto complainant and the petitioners are brothers, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

7.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Sathankulam, Thoothukudi District, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(a)the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioners shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

(c)the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;



(f)if the accused/petitioners thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
